Imports from China

Most of the shipping lines have introduced new Ultra Large Containers Vessels in the trade between Asia and Europe. At the same time the slow speed programs are fine-tuned further resulting in a shortage of empty equipments in certain ports. Especially 20ft containers are not always available. Surcharges are levied by certain shipping lines in China. They can be changed with or without prior notice.

Despite the increase of capacity it seems freight rates remain steady for Q3.

Our import team is at your disposal to find options via other ports by sea freight. Sea-air shipments have been proven to be a suitable option on imports from China and South-East Asia, either via Dubai, via South Korea or even via Canada.

Air freight : Brussels Airlines Cargo flies to more destinations in West Africa

From July onwards, Brussels Airlines will commence four flights a week to and from Accra, Ghana via Monrovia, Liberia. Ouagadougou in Burkina Faso will be served with two weekly flights in combination with Abidjan, Ivory Coast.

New twice-weekly operations will also add Lome, Togo and Cotonou, Benin. This besides the 18 destinations which are already served in Africa.
